CONTEST RULES

This contest is open to University of Richmond students, faculty, staff, and alumni. Winning entries may be displayed in the Carole Weinstein International Center, included in future University publications, and/or showcased on the CGE website. All submissions may be used in the promotion of the University and its study abroad programs.

To enter, carefully read the eligibility requirements and selection criteria below and make your submissions by March 13th.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. All returned study abroad students, international students, exchange students, alumni, faculty, and staff ("entrants") may participate in the contest.
2. Photos must be original works (entries from professional photographers are not allowed) and have been captured by the entrant.
3. Photos may be color or black and white and must be submitted as high-resolution digital files.
4. A maximum of three photos may be submitted per entrant.
5. Returned study abroad students should submit photos taken during their program abroad.
6. International students (degree-seeking and exchange) may submit photos taken during their time in the United States.
7. Alumni, faculty, and staff may submit photos from business or leisure travel taken within the past 12 months.
8. Entries become the property of the University of Richmond and may be edited and reproduced for publication in electronic or print form to promote the University and its related programs and activities.

SELECTION CRITERIA

A panel of University adjudicators will review all entries. The winning photos will then be eligible for the “People’s Choice Award” badge, which will be decided by voting on the Center for Global Engagement’s Instagram page (@global_richmond).

The best submissions will capture the entrant and their exploration and engagement with the host culture. Other selection criteria include:

- Technical and artistic merit (clarity, focus, lighting, etc.)
- Photos exhibiting the entrant’s experience abroad (e.g. academic learning, cultural learning, international awareness, cultural sensitivity, or fun)
- An original approach to the subject matter

PRIZES

Winning entrants will receive prizes valued at up to \$35, and their photographs may be displayed in the International Center, included in future University publications, and showcased on University websites and social media.
